WAIKATO-TAINUI TERTIARY EDUCATION GRANT

(FOR UNDERGRADUATE LEVELS)

TUMATE MAHUTA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

(FOR POST-GRADUATE AND MASTERS LEVELS)

- i The closing dates for tertiary education grant/scholarship applications is Friday 28 February 2014.
- ii Grants and Scholarships are available to registered tribal members who are resident in New Zealand and who are studying at a tertiary education institution in New Zealand. Grants and scholarships are available for full-time and part-time study.
- iii Priority will be given to those students applying in the following areas of study:
 - Sciences (including environmental)
 - Business Management
 - Early Childhood Teaching
 - Engineering
 - Medicine/Surgery/Nursing
 - Maatauranga Maori/Te ReoConsideration will be given to all other tertiary programme applications.
- iv The tenure of the grant is one year. Applicants must submit a new application each year.
- v Grants will contribute towards **tuition fees only**. Applicants must provide certified evidence of their:
 - 2014 Year of study (e.g. yr 1 of one year certificate, yr 1 of two year diploma, year 1 of three year degree)
 - 2014 NZQA Level of Qualification (e.g. level 4 – first yr of certificate, level 5 – first yr of degree, level 8 – post graduate diploma, level 9 – masters)
 - Official confirmation of enrolment (interim or conditional enrolments will not be considered)
 - Official name of qualification
 - Status of study (e.g. full-time or part-time)
 - 2014 course finish date
 - List of courses/subjects
 - 2014 course start date
 - 2014 course invoice (stating tuition component of fees)The above information must be on the learning institution's official letterhead
- vi Grants in consecutive years will depend on academic record. Applicants must pass a minimum of 75% of courses to be eligible for further grants.
- vii Applicants who have received a grant from WRLT in previous years, must supply a copy of their official academic results transcript (verified online documentation will be accepted) for their most recent year of tertiary study. Applicants who did not receive a grant in their most recent year of study, must supply a copy of their official academic results transcripts for the year in which they last received a tertiary education grant.
- viii The MAXIMUM number of grants awarded to any one applicant is six (three at 'Under Graduate Level', three at 'Post Graduate' and/or 'Masters Level')
- ix A personal statement is required to support every application. Applicants must provide a minimum of 100 words outlining their current involvement with their Waikato-Tainui Marae/Iwi and their intended contribution to their Waikato-Tainui Marae/Iwi in the future.
- x Personal statements will be forwarded to the respective Waikato-Tainui Marae committee for their information.
- xi Incomplete applications will not be considered and will be returned to the postal address as stated on the application.
- xii If an applicant withdraws from their course or individual papers prior to receiving funding, or after receiving funding they must notify WRLT. If this does not occur, an applicant may not be eligible for further grants.
- xiii Upon graduation, all successful grant recipients must provide WRLT a verified copy of their certificate, diploma and/or degree.
- xiv WRLT may require successful applicants to participate in tribal activities such as Poukai and Koroneihana, as a condition of the grant. Notification of any requirement will be provided to successful applicants. WRLT reserves the right to use a successful applicant's name and other details for publicity and promotion purposes.
- xv. WRLT has the sole discretion to accept or decline any application that does not meet grant criteria.
