Wintec have teamed up with Hamilton-based manufacturer Longveld to offer a unique training course for young women interested in a career in fabrication and engineering.

It will see young women, at year 11 and 12 level from Waikato Trades Academy Partnership school, visit Wintec's workshop one day a week. They'll build a fuel powered mini-bike, while gaining credits towards their NCEA Level 2, and spend up to 5 days gaining on-the-job work experience at Longveld.

## Compulsory work experience

Work experience is compulsory for **all** students enrolled in this programme. Students will be expected to attend one five (5) day block of work experience during the July or October school holidays. They will be put into a group of six to eight (6-8) students, so that they have another student with them in the workshop at all times during the work experience.

**Please note this is in addition to the one (1) day of study completed at Wintec each week from February to November.**
