PRACTICUM REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to undertake a practicum placement in a licensed, chartered Early Childhood setting for a minimum of 12 hours per week for the whole of the academic year. It is your responsibility to ensure that you have made satisfactory arrangements with an ECE setting prior to the programme commencing. All students are required to independently attain a comprehensive First Aid Certificate (covering Unit Standards 6400, 6401 and 6402) during the first year of the programme. The course you take must be on the list approved by the Ministry of Education.

1. Teaching Experience

All students are required to attend a full-time teaching experience for three weeks in Year 1, in a different Early Childhood centre. Teaching Experience placements will be allocated by Wintec. Please make sure that your employer is aware of the dates when you will be absent from work. These will be 6 November – 24 November 2017


2. Workshop Day

TEMPORARY STUDENT PARKING PERMIT - Display this clearly on your dashboard
