PRACTICUM REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to undertake a practicum placement in a licensed, early childhood setting for a minimum of 12 hours per week for the whole of the academic year. It is your responsibility to ensure that you have made satisfactory arrangements with an ECE setting prior to the programme commencing. FIRST AID CERTIFICATE

All students are required to independently attain a comprehensive First Aid Certificate (covering Unit Standards 6400, 6401 and 6402) during the first year of the programme. The course you take must be on the list approved by the Ministry of Education.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS – During the course of the programme there are three other attendance requirements.

1. Teaching Experience

All students are required to attend a full-time teaching experience for three weeks in Year 1, in a different Early Childhood education centre. Teaching Experience placements will be allocated by Wintec. Please make sure that your practicum setting is aware of the dates when you will be absent from practicum. Teaching experience for Stream D will take place in Semester 1, 2018.

2. Workshop Day

One-day interactive, hands on workshops designed for fun and creativity for **all** ECE students, held annually (date to be advised). This is a compulsory component of the programme which you will be required to attend.

3. Marae Noho

The marae noho is a compulsory three day two night stay which occurs in each year of the Bachelor of Teaching (ECE) programme. This will be held from 2 to 4 August 2017.

TEMPORARY STUDENT PARKING PERMIT - Display this clearly on your dashboard

This permit allows you to park at Wintec for your FIRST WEEK FREE to give you time to organise your permanent parking permit. If this permit is not displayed, you **MUST** have a permanent parking permit and a 'pay and display' ticket on your vehicle dashboard.

PERMANENT PARKING PERMIT

Your permanent parking permit must be displayed after your first week along with a 'pay and display' ticket on your vehicle dashboard to avoid parking infringements.
