Thank you for your application for our SPACE (Self-Paced Applied Computer Education) modules.

The SPACE modules are delivered in class with students working from self-paced manuals provided by Wintec. Students work at their own pace, however, there is a facilitator on hand to assist students when needed.

There are six modules available:

FOSP205B PowerPoint FOSP206B Internet and Email

Students are required to complete a module, including the assessment, before they will be enrolled in a new module.

Students will be required to attend an interview to complete their enrolment documentation. Students will be contacted by the course facilitator regarding the date and time of their interview. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT STUDENTS ATTEND THEIR INTERVIEW.

At the Interview, students will be advised of the module requirements and course expectations. Students will also book the sessions they will attend each week. Please note: It is a requirement that students book in, and attend, TWO class sessions each week.

Attendance in the SPACE sessions will be closely monitored. Any student who has not attended for two weeks will be automatically withdrawn.

Enrolments for SPACE modules are ongoing throughout the year. However modules may be closed to new enrolments if enrolments exceed maximum numbers.

# TEMPORARY STUDENT PARKING PERMIT - Display this clearly on your dashboard


