## **ADDITIONAL COSTS**

Students interested in progressing to the Certificate in Animal Technology (L5) - Veterinary Nursing Assistant strand require 12 credits in NCEA level 2 math. Students that do not meet this requirement have the option to sit an online math assessment which will incur an additional charge. For any student who does not meet the required pass mark, the test fee provides access to individualised, self-directed online tutorials to develop the math abilities required for entry to the VNA programme. These students will have the option to re sit the test at a later date.
