PERMANENT PARKING PERMIT

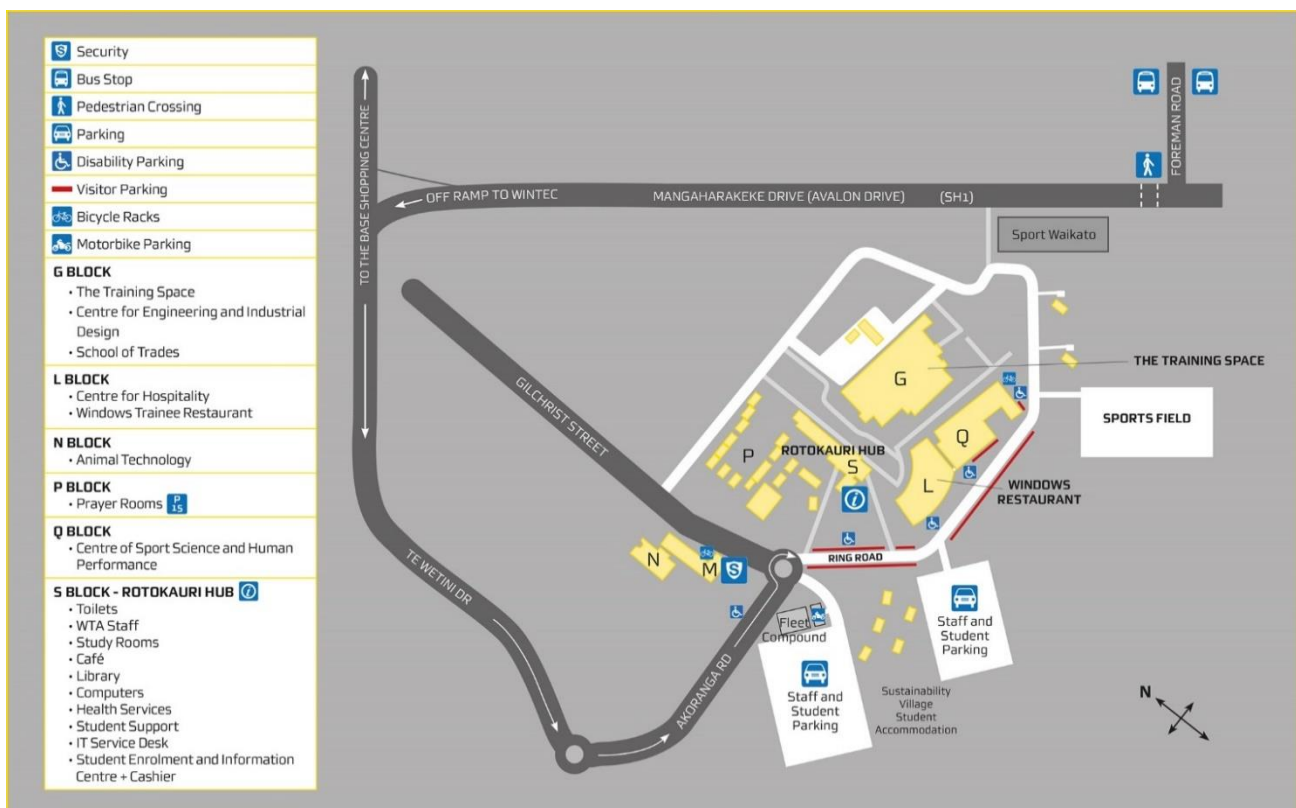
TIMETABLES
