TO FIND YOUR CLASS STREAM

Your initial class streams will be listed on your Enrolment Offer you signed or Accepted online; it will be a letter from A – D beside the module/paper you are taking under ‘**Tutorial Stream**’. 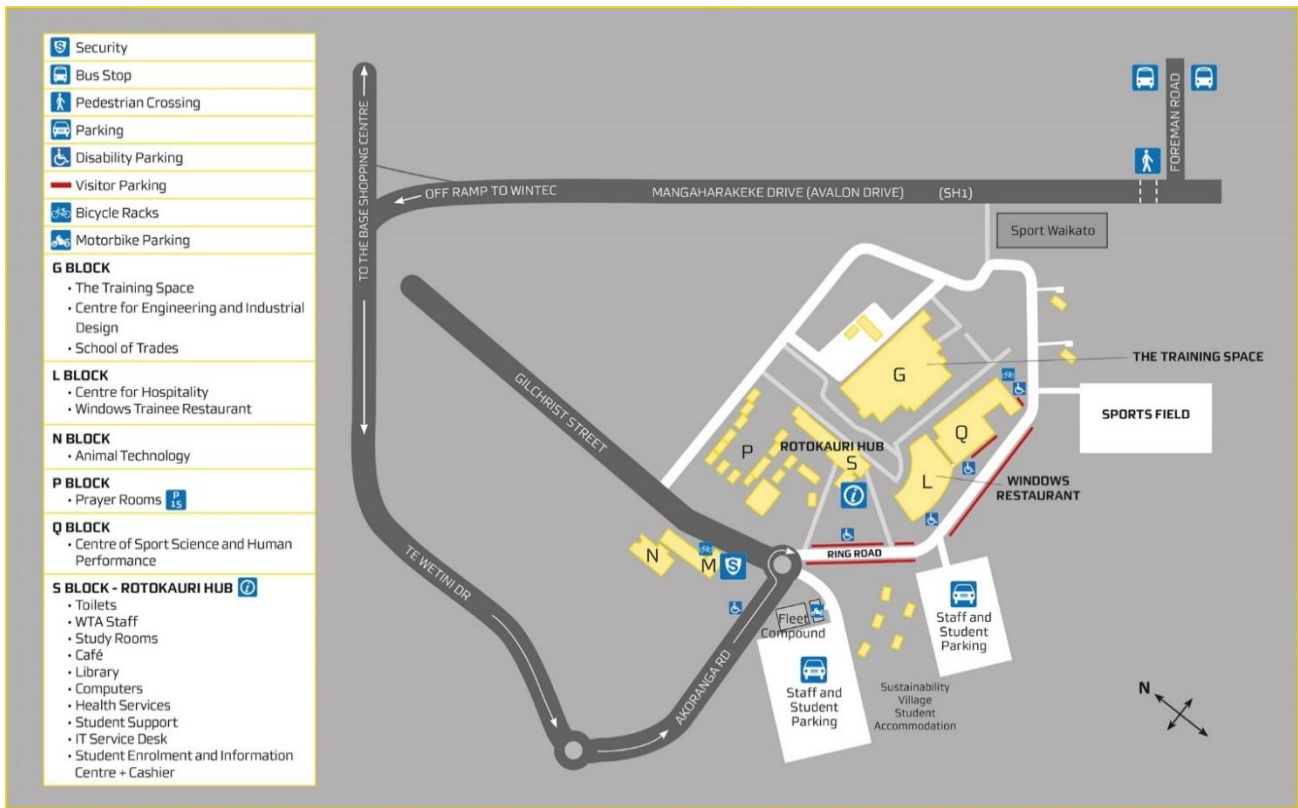
PERMANENT PARKING PERMIT
