HEALTH STATUS

All students must have completed a health screening form and be cleared for clinical practice placement. Evidence of vaccination is required otherwise Immunisation status must be ascertained by a blood test arranged by your doctor/health provider, there will be associated costs. Forms will be available at interviews.

Methicillin-Resistant Staphylococcus Aureus (MRSA) - Students must be screened for MRSA before the first clinical placement. At other times throughout the programme, repeated MRSA screening may be required.

FIRST AID CERTIFICATE

All students must have a current comprehensive first aid certificate (Covering NZQA credits 6400, 6401 & 6402 or equivalent). A copy of which must be on your file with Student Enrolment and Information Centre (SEIC). If you do not have a current first aid certificate you will not be given a clinical placement.

UNIFORM FOR PRACTICE

Our uniform supplier will be at WINTEC, week beginning 13 February, to custom fit uniforms to order.

TEMPORARY STUDENT PARKING PERMIT - Display this clearly on your dashboard

Your permanent parking permit must be displayed after your first week along with a 'pay and display' ticket on your vehicle dashboard to avoid parking infringements.


