PERMANENT PARKING PERMIT

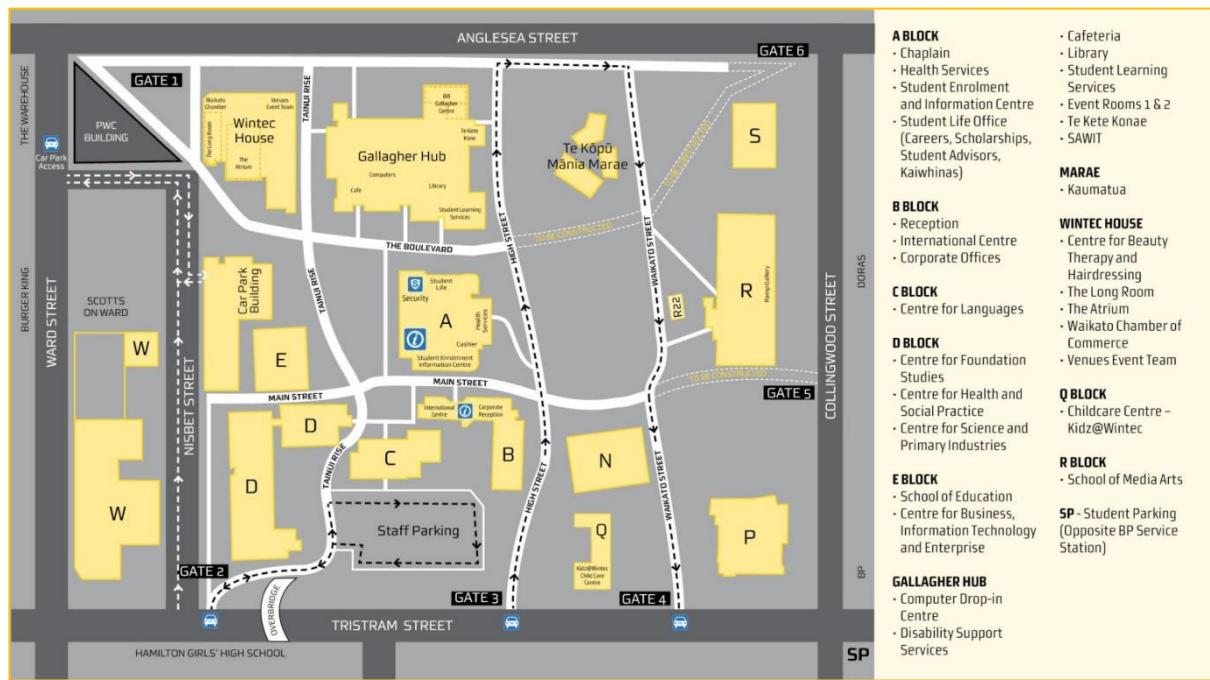
Your permanent parking permit must be displayed after your first week along with a 'pay and display' ticket on your vehicle dashboard to avoid parking infringements.

HOW TO FIND YOUR WAY AROUND – Wintec City Campus

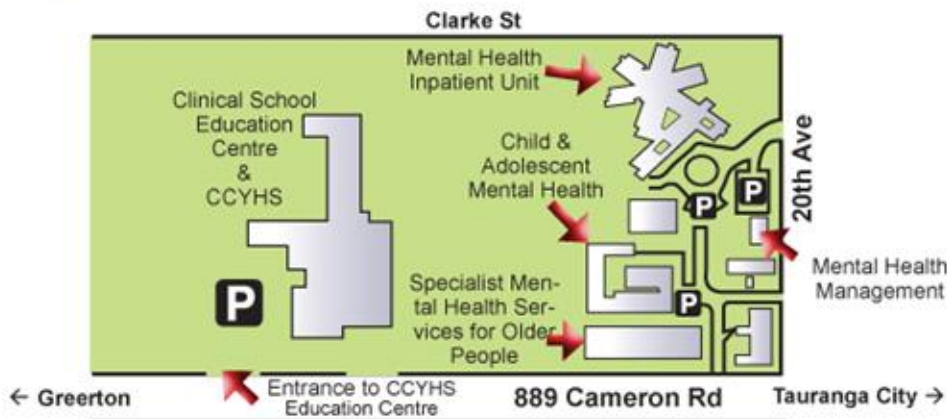


HOW TO FIND YOUR WAY AROUND - Tauranga Campus
