QUALIFICATIONS

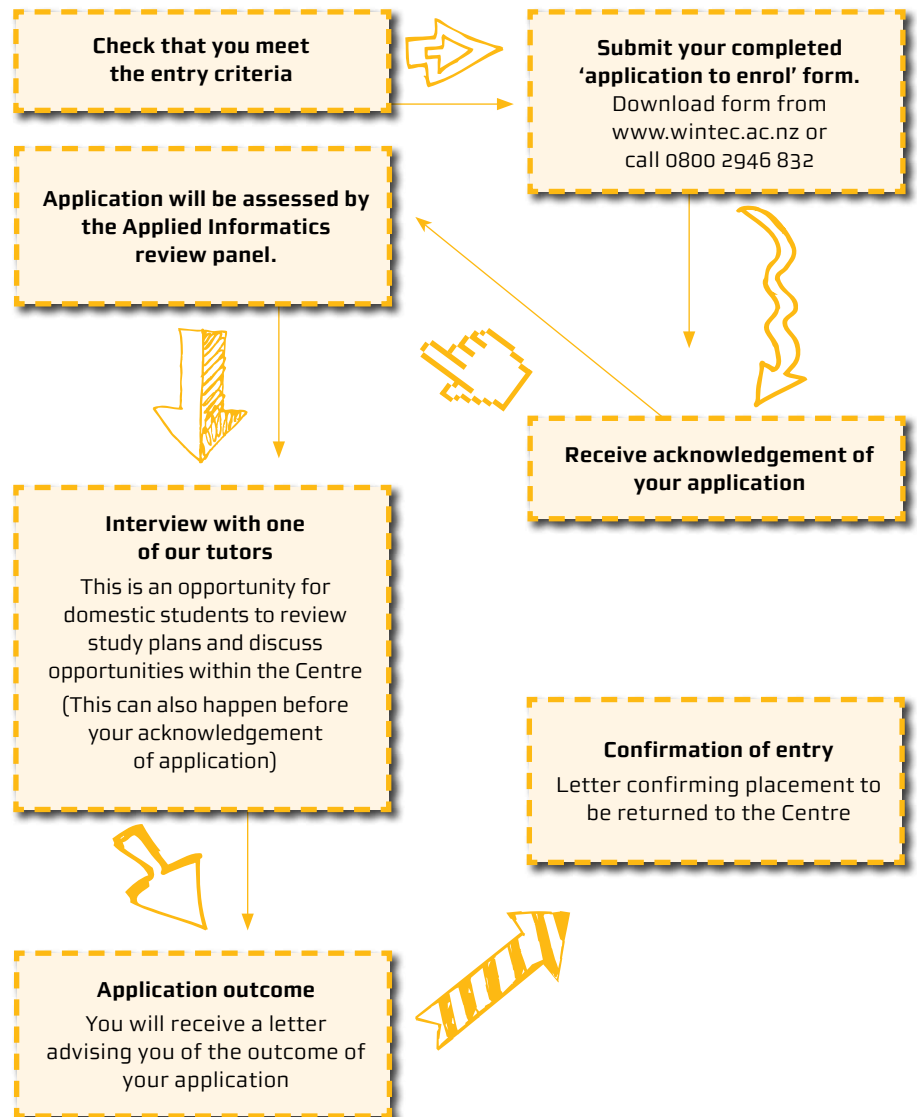
A degree (or equivalent), that incorporates applied IT studies; or any other degree (or equivalent) and at least two year's experience of designing and/or developing and/or customising an information system in a business context (including the education, health, government and not-for-profit sectors).

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Candidates who have English as a second language are required to have an International English Language Test System (IELTS) score of 6.5, with no individual band score lower than 6.0; or equivalent.
